Over the past 28 years (including 2015 through 9/28), the S\&P 500 Total Return Index has experienced an average intra-year decline of - $13.5 \%$. The index experienced a decline of more than $-10 \%$ in nearly half of all years (13 out of 28 ). Despite these declines, the index had a negative calendar year return only six times in 28 years.
